## MATH LITERACY

One of our school goals is to increase students' speed in recalling math facts. Here are a couple of ideas you can do at home to help your child improve with their math facts.

1) War - using a regular deck of cards, or a game that has numbered cards, you can play a variety of math fact games. a) Multiplication war each turn over a card and the first to multiply and get the correct answer gets the cards - here you could adapt it to how high you wanted to practice - up to the five times table.
b) Addition war - flip two cards over and the first to correctly say the sum wins the cards.
c) Subtraction war - flip over two cards and the first to correctly say the answer wins the cards.
2) Learning to count forwards and backwards - as you set the table count the cutlery - as you clean off the table subtract and count down as you take the cutlery off the table.
